PELVIC C CLAMP, PELVIC INSTRUMENT SET)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0606

WHEREAS, the Philippine Orthopedic Center (POC) advertised the Invitation to Bid for the Public Bidding for One (1) Lot Supply and Delivery of OR Instruments (Hip Extraction Instrumentation, Foot Instruments, Pelvic C Clamp and Pelvic Instrument Set) in the PhilGEPS Website on August 11, 2020. The Invitation to Bid was likewise posted in the hospital premises;

WHEREAS, the deadline for submission of bids was set on 01 September 2020 @ 09:00 A.M. The opening of bid was @ 09:30 A.M. of the same date at the 3rd Floor Auditorium Room of this hospital;

WHEREAS, invitations to sit as observers during pre-bid conference and bid opening were sent to the following personages:

1. MR. DANNY ROYECA of Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry
2. MR. CONRADO CANO of Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers
3. MR. AMADOR F. ESTUDILLO of Procurement Watch
4. POC-COA RESIDENT AUDITOR;

WHEREAS, after advertisement only one (1) prospective bidder, ZUELLIG PHARMA CORPORATION responded in the aforementioned public bidding. From the date of publication up to the closing date, no other interested bidder/s submitted letter of intent.

WHEREAS, upon opening of the first bid envelope as submitted by the participating lone bidder, the POC-BAC found that said bidder complied with all the documents required to be submitted for the first component of the bid. Hence, the POC-BAC rated said lone bidder as PASSED using a non-discretionary "PASS/FAIL" criteria;

WHEREAS, after determining compliance with the requirements in the first envelope, the POC-BAC opened the second bid envelope. Hereunder the result:

1. The lone bidder complied with the documents required to be submitted for the second component of bid.
2. The bid item was actually placed on bid under this category with submitted bid quotation from the lone bidder.
3. The bid proposal on the bid item from the lone bidder is within the price ceiling and was initially found to be substantially complying.



WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG), after thorough review and detailed evaluation of the specifications and bid price of the lone bidder and in consultation with the end-users, came up with the following findings:


The bid offer of ZUELLIG PHARMA CORPORATION is in conformity with the required standards of the hospital and found to be responsive. Hence, the bid offer of ZUELLIG PHARMA CORPORATION is considered as Single Calculated Responsive Bid (SCRB).


WHEREAS, the POC-BAC, after thorough and careful examination, validation and verification of all eligibility requirements and bid documents submitted by the eligible bidder with the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid (LCRB) and/or Single Calculated Responsive Bid (SCRB) during its post-qualification, agreed with the findings of TWG, hereby resolve as it is hereby resolved to:

1. Declare the considered lone bidder as bidder with Single Calculated Responsive Bid.
2. Recommend award to ZUELLIG PHARMA CORPORATION of One (1) Lot Supply and Delivery of OR Instruments (Hip Extraction Instrumentation, Foot Instruments, Pelvic C Clamp and Pelvic Instrument Set) amounting to Php 12,409,317.00; and,
3. Recommend for approval by the Medical Center Chief II the foregoing findings and recommendations.
