



INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO BID (IAEB)

PUBLIC BIDDING FOR ONE (1) LOT CONSTRUCTION/REHABILITATION OF FOUR (4) PHILIPPINE ORTHOPEDIC CENTER (POC) FACILITIES

1. The Philippine Orthopedic Center (POC), through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) 2022 intends to apply the sum of Ten Million Pesos (PhP10,000,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for PUBLIC BIDDING FOR ONE (1) LOT CONSTRUCTION/REHABILITATION OF FOUR (4) PHILIPPINE ORTHOPEDIC CENTER (POC) FACILITIES. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening;
2. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".
3. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorship, partnerships, or organizations with at least seventy-five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines
4. Eligible bidders must satisfy the requirements of the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) at least Category B.
5. Interested bidders may obtain further information from BAC Secretariat, BAC Office, POC, Ma. Clara cor. Banawe Sts., Quezon City and inspect the Bidding Documents from 8:00A.M. to 4:00P.M. during weekdays
6. A complete set of Eligibility Requirements may be purchased by interested bidders from the address below after their submission of Letter of Intent (LOI) and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee for each Bidding Documents pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB.

7. The following are the Schedule of Activities (*Earliest possible timeline*):

8. The following eligibility/legal documents shall be submitted on or before July 11, 2022 at the address below:
 - DTI business name registration in the case of Single Proprietorships; or SEC registration certificate, in the case of Partnerships or Corporations;
 - Valid and current Mayor's permit/municipal license to operate a business;
 - BIR Registration Certificate, which contains the Taxpayer's Identification Number;
 - Omnibus Sworn Statement;
 - Tax Clearance Certificate issued by the BIR Main Office and Income or Business Tax Returns filed through the EFPS (E.O. 398, s. 2005), if Applicable;
 - The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the immediately preceding calendar year, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities

- Proof of the prospective bidder's capacity to absorb the additional obligations in connection with the contract to be bid and to finance its implementation/completion:
 - The prospective bidder's computation of its NFCC which shall be in accordance with Section 23.11.2.5 of the IRR-A; or
 - A certificate of commitment specific to the contract at hand, issued by a licensed bank to extend to it a credit line if awarded the contract to be bid, which shall be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABC; or
 - A cash deposit certificate certifying a hold out on cash deposits issued by a licensed bank, which shall also be specific to the contract to be bid, in an amount not lower than that set by the Procuring Entity in the Bidding Documents, which shall be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABC.
 - Statement of the bidder's SLCC similar to the contract to be bid, except under conditions provided for in 2016 IRR Section 23.4.2.4
 - Valid JVA, if the prospective bidder is a joint venture, with the agreement containing a statement on who the joint venture/association has constituted and appointed as the lawful attorney-in-fact to sign the contract, if awarded the project, and on who among the members is the lead representative of the joint venture
9. POC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders. For further information, please refer to:
